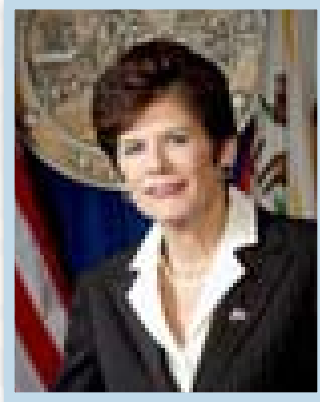

### **A Report on How to Avoid Identity Theft**
